

Vladivostok Prays for Japan



Back Ground

The 2011 Sendai earthquake and tsunami, literally "Tōhoku region Pacific Ocean offshore earthquake") was a 9.0 M. mega thrust earthquake off the coast of Japan that occurred at 14:46 pm (15:46 Vladivostok time) on 11 March 2011. The earthquake triggered tsunami with waves high as 10m and washed 10km inland.

The Japanese National Police Agency has officially confirmed 1597 deaths, 1743 injuries, and 1085 people missing across twelve prefectures, but estimated numbers are far higher, as 10,000 deaths. The earthquake caused extensive damage in Japan, including heavy damage to roads and railways as well as fires in many areas, dam collapse, and melt down of 2 Nuclear Power Plants. Around 4.4 million households in northeastern Japan are still left without electricity and 1.4 million without water.
